NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUBSTITUTE COUNSEL

Comes now the Appellant, Dallan Timothy Thorstenson, and hereby notifies the Court and the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense (SCCID) of his intent to substitute appellate counsel in the above-captioned matter.

This notice is based on the documented refusal of appointed counsel Joanna K. Delany to file prerequisite motions related to the September 30, 2025 reconstruction hearing, which is critical to the protection of Appellant's rights.


Further, Appellant asserts that counsel's ongoing involvement and the conduct of certain judiciary and prosecutorial actors constitute a criminal conspiracy and obstruction of justice directly impacting this case, for which Appellant intends to pursue criminal charges.

Due to counsel's failure to act and this broader obstruction, Appellant respectfully requests immediate appointment of substitute counsel, or in the alternative leave to proceed pro se pending assignment of competent replacement counsel, to preserve Appellant's constitutional right to effective assistance of counsel.

PETITION FOR WRIT OF SUPERVISORY CONTROL

NOW COMES Petitioner, Dallan Timothy Thorstenson, DOC No. 392694, respectfully petitions this Court to exercise its supervisory control over the South Carolina Court of Appeals and SCCID to prevent ongoing procedural abuse, miscarriage of justice, and constitutional violations related to Petitioner's appellate record reconstruction and denial of effective counsel.

GROUNDINGS FOR RELIEF

1. The South Carolina Court of Appeals and SCCID have allowed cumulative errors and neglect, including destruction of critical records, improper reconstruction procedures, and counsel abandonment impacting Petitioner's right to meaningful appeal and due process.
2. These actions constitute an abuse of discretion that necessitates extraordinary supervisory intervention to restore integrity and fairness.
3. Without this Court's intervention, Petitioner faces irreparable harm to constitutionally protected rights under federal and state law.
4. Petitioner is a disabled veteran whose circumstances require immediate judicial protection and oversight to prevent manifest injustice.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Petitioner prays this Court:

- Issue a writ of supervisory control directing the Court of Appeals and SCCID to comply with their legal and constitutional obligations;
- Stay all reconstruction hearings and decisions until fair procedures are ensured;
- Provide any additional relief the Court deems necessary to protect Petitioner's rights.
