ORDER

On June 13, 2025, Appellants filed their designation of matter, which included "Defense Demonstratives 4, 8(a)." On September 12, 2025, Respondents filed a motion to strike "Defense Demonstratives 4, 8(a)" from Appellants' designation of matter because these matters were not introduced at trial. On September 17, 2025, Appellants filed a return, arguing "Defense Demonstratives 4, 8(a)" were properly designated as they were presented to the master-in-equity. After careful consideration, we deny Respondents' motion to strike. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The [r]ecord shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal.").
