ORDER

After careful consideration, we dismiss the appeal because the order granting attendant care benefits during the claimant's recovery period is interlocutory and not immediately appealable. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-380 (Supp. 2024) ("A party who has exhausted all administrative remedies available within the agency and who is aggrieved by a final decision in a contested case is entitled to judicial review pursuant to this article and Article 1. . . . A preliminary, procedural, or intermediate agency action or ruling is immediately reviewable if review of the final agency decision would not provide an adequate remedy."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
