

Please let me know if I need to do anything further to obtain a briefing schedule.



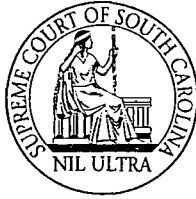
