**Appellants’ Motion to Strike Respondents Designation of Matter to  
be Included in the Record on Appeal**

---

Appellants (Hannah Secka, and (M.Y.N.S.) files this Motion to Strike the  
February 20, 2024, Hearing Transcript in Respondents’ Designation of Matter to be  
included in the Record on Appeal. Pursuant to Rule 103, “Rulings on Evidence.” As  
stated, Rule 103 evidence “must be confined to the record” S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-  
380(4); *Argabright v. Argabright*, 398 S.C. 176, 179, 727 S.E.2d 748, 750 (2012)  
which itself may contain only matter that was “presented to the lower court or

tribunal.” Rule 210(c), SCACR. Appellate courts are unable to accept new evidence. See, e.g., *State v. Harris*, 391 S.C. 539, 545, 706 S.E.2d 526, 529 (Ct. App. 2011).

While appellate courts will occasionally take judicial notice of certain facts, such judicial notice “should be limited to matters which are indisputable.” *Masters v. Rodgers Dev. Grp.*, 283 S.C. 251, 256, 321 S.E.2d 194, 197 (Ct. App. 1984).

Further, as stated, these materials are not relevant to the sole issue of appeal.
