Re: June 18, 2025 Transcript – Material Omissions/Alterations; Request for Corrected Certified Transcript & Preservation of Originals

Dear Ms. Holmes and Court Reporting Office,

I respectfully submit this request for administrative review and correction of the transcript for the June 18, 2025 proceeding in *Attia Elbadawy v. D.R. Horton, Inc., et al.* (Dorchester County Circuit Court). The transcript provided appears to contain material omissions and alterations affecting the integrity of the record.

Specific Issues Identified

1. Caption/Omissions on Page 1: The appearance/caption page omits co■plaintiff **Lynne Chatlos** as a named plaintiff.
2. Substantive Deletions: Statements made by attorney **Mark Bible** that are relevant to the issues in dispute appear to be missing from the transcript.
3. Discontinuities/Truncation: Multiple passages read as discontinuous or redacted without any notation (e.g., “[inaudible]” or “[omission]”), suggesting unmarked alterations.
4. Certification Concerns: The transcript as delivered does not represent a complete and accurate record of the proceeding.

Requests for Relief

1. Immediate review and issuance of a **corrected, certified transcript** reflecting a complete and accurate record.
2. Entry of a **preservation hold** over all original reporter materials for June 18, 2025 (audio, stenographic notes, and work product).

3. Production of: (a) the reporter's **certificate and index**; (b) the **official audio recording** (if maintained) or other raw capture; and (c) an **errata/addendum log** that itemizes every change with page/line references.

4. A brief written explanation describing how the defects occurred and the quality control steps to prevent recurrence.

5. A target timeline for completion so I can meet appellate and related court deadlines.

I can promptly supply a marked up copy of the transcript with page/line citations and exhibits that highlight the omissions. Please confirm receipt and identify the assigned contact for follow up.
