Please accept this letter as an update for the above referenced appeal.

While continuously updating bankruptcy documents for 13 creditors, on June 11, 2025 following the Chapter 13 Creditor's meeting, my phone and computer became completely inoperable. On July 22, 2025 the Chapter 13 Trustee filed a motion to dismiss with prejudice. While attempting to recreate important tax documents to address a Proof of Claim filed by the IRS, I learned that I had to pursue a fresh start program with the IRS, outside of the Bankruptcy proceedings.

On August 19, 2025, I filed a motion to withdraw prior to confirmation, as permitted by Fed. Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

Respondent's attorney Mr. Wyman filed an objection to my withdrawal and requested that my bankruptcy case be dismissed with prejudice. On August 29, 2025, the US Bankruptcy Court issued a dismissal without prejudice. I sought reconsideration and clarification as to whether the order constituted a withdrawal or dismissal. On September 12, 2025, I filed a Notice of Appeal
30nd I am currently in receipt of a Court Order from the U.S. District Court to provide certain documents by October 17, 2025.
