**MOTION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS**

NOW COMES, the Petitioner, Regina M. Hunter El to ask the Court to proceed *In Forma*

*Pauperis* for the following reasons:

1. Here, the Petitioner argues that the Court should allow her to proceed *In Forma Pauperis* because the filing fee was waived for the Plaintiff in the lower court.
