

## ORDER

---

Because Appellant alleges he is entitled to a refund of money he was charged for medications while incarcerated, we grant his motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. See *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 535, 471 S.E.2d 134, 134-35 (1995) ("Motions to proceed *in forma pauperis* may be granted only when authorized by statute or required by constitutional provisions."); *Millholland v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 436 S.C. 547, 549, 873 S.E.2d 784, 785 (Ct. App. 2022) (indicating inmates have a protected property interest in their inmate accounts).
