MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel respectfully requests a thirty day extension in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court Monday, November 11, 2013.
2. Counsel respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



On November 1, 2013, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Dewayne C. Hagins v. State with this Court. On October 21, 2013, counsel filed the brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Austin Epperson in the Court of Appeals. On October 18, 2013, Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Travis D. Robinson v. State with this Court. On October 16, 2013, counsel, as co-counsel, filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Don-Survi Chisolm in the Court of Appeals. On October 3, 2013, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix on Michael Lee Jones v. State with this Court. On October 2, 2013, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Leroy Brown v. State with this Court. On September 30, 2013, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Adrian Lawrence with the Court of Appeals. On September 10, 2013, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Darrell Florez with the Court of Appeals. On September 6, 2013, counsel filed an initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Damon T. Brown with the Court of Appeals.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.


