

RETURN TO ORDER

On September 10, 2025, this Court issued an Order requiring the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense (hereinafter SCCID) to screen Appellant and determine if he qualifies for the services of the Office of Appellate Defense in connection with this appeal. Based upon the affidavit of indigency submitted by Appellant, SCCID deems him indigent and thus qualified for representation by SCCID if the present appeal would fall under the statutory or constitutional duties and responsibilities of the Division of Appellate Defense.
