ORDER

This post-conviction relief (PCR) case arises out of guilty pleas entered in 1997. Except for the *White v. State*¹ claim, the PCR judge held that all other claims were barred by the statute of limitation. As to the *White v. State* claim, the PCR judge held that petitioner is not entitled to a belated direct appeal.

Except for the *White v. State* claim, petitioner has failed to provide an adequate explanation under Rule 243(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). As to the *White v. State* claim, petitioner has failed to provide an adequate explanation under Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR, for an appeal from a guilty plea.

Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221, SCACR.
