The Court received your correspondence inquiring about a hearing date, your difficulty procuring an attorney, your request for translation services, and whether any additional materials are required for your appeal.

At this time, our records reflect the transcript has been ordered, but not delivered. Once you receive the transcript, you will have thirty (30) days to serve and file your appellant's initial brief and designation of matter, as set forth by Rules 208 and 209, SCACR. We have enclosed a copy of the appeals chart, which can be found in Part II, Appendix B, to the SCACR, to help you understand the timelines for perfecting an appeal.

We do not typically set our cases for a hearing. Most of the decisions at the Court of Appeals are based on the written submissions from the parties. We recommend you contact the South Carolina Bar by calling (803) 799-7100 if you are seeking the services of an attorney. We do not provide translation services for written submissions to the Court of Appeals, and this matter is not set for a hearing at this time.

Your letters also reference difficulties in serving the respondent. You can accomplish service pursuant to Rule 262, SCACR, by depositing a copy of your filing with the Court in the US mail addressed to the person's last known address with sufficient first class postage attached. We do not require proof that the respondent actually received a copy of the filing.
