The Claimant/Respondent acknowledges receipt of the Petitioners' Brief on September 15, 2025. After careful review, and while expressly maintaining disagreement with the substantive merits of the Petitioners' underlying appeal, the Claimant/Respondent concurs with the Petitioners' position that the issue presently before this Court is immediately appealable. Specifically, the Claimant/Respondent agrees that the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission Appellate Panel's determination of compensability constitutes a final decision.
