MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Roderick Dover respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension from October 17, 2025 until November 17, 2025, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel attended and presented at the mandatory Annual South Carolina Public

Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina from October 6-8, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Robert DeJesus with this Court on October 2, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Terry S. Tyler with the Supreme Court on September 19, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Alan G. Nix with this Court on September 15, 2025. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Rehearing in the case of Holly Jo Thompson v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 15, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Keldrekus T. Oglesby v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 12, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari, the Brief of Petitioner pursuant to *White v. State*, and the Appendix in the case of Euzema Maurice Austin v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 8, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Donnell L. Washington v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 5, 2025. Counsel filed the Reply Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Michael Lindsay Faile with this Court on September 2, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Jonathan Keith Bass with this Court on August 29, 2025.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On September 25, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by


Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through October 31, 2025.
