MyName is Goldie Grier Reeves And I Am responding to your request to file a return to my Counsel's request to withdraw. Mr. Daniels HadHas been helping me with this case for several Years. It was indeed a blessing that I was able to work with him because since a relationship began I have been stricken with two strokes and colon Cancer. My strokes have severely hindered my ability to write in order to communicate or express myself. Further I have been handicapped by certain memory loss which has affected my ability to communicate my ideas with others, particularly Mr. Daniels. Who Has displayed a remarkable amount of patience and dedication. For which I am sincerely grateful.

It is true that I paid Mr. Daniels the two thousand dollar retainer as he requested in the beginning. However he has never asked me for more funds as a fee. I did meet with Mr. Daniels and MY Account to determine what funds we would need and for the case, These were placed in Mr. Daniels Trust Account and used for a number of specialists and evaluations or tests needed for this case. I was not fortunate enough to raise any more funds. I am very sorry I can not pay him any more at this time.

This case involves a multiple number of legal disciplines including construction and real estate, personal and business contracts Trusts and Medicine. It actually took me four years to find an attorney capable of handling all these disciplines, I would prefer Mr. Daniels not withdraw as my counsel as there are several situations he needs to address if he would be so kind to do so.

Mr. Daniels has a remarkable knowledge of the statutes and he has a remarkable memory. I believe he can recall most all of what I have shared with him and when.

The arbitration we went through recently has no transcript.


