On October 15, 2025 I received the remittitur on the above case. I also received an order on the above case dated August 28, 2025 pursuant to the above case.


These two (2) documents were received at the same time. Being that the order was dated August 28, 2025, I never had the opportunity to appeal the ruling.

Any attempt of a post trial motion was thwarted by your actions. Being that the full filing fee was paid, how can we rectify or resolve this matter.

Roth, 408 U.S. 564, 569
