


ORDER


On July 17, 2025, this court granted a temporary stay of the circuit court's order on appeal and remanded Appellant's request for a stay to the circuit court. Thereafter, the circuit court issued an order granting Appellant's request for a stay contingent upon an undertaking pursuant to section 27-40-800(f) of the South Carolina Code (2007). On August 14, 2025, this court denied Green's motion to reduce the amount of the undertaking or stay the circuit court order without an undertaking. On September 17, 2025, Appellant filed a "motion to stay order/judgment pending appeal," requesting this court stay the circuit court's order pending appeal without requiring an undertaking. On October 9, 2025, Respondents filed a return, opposing Appellant's request.¹ On September 19, 2025, Appellant filed a motion to reconsider the petition for writ of supersedeas. We construe Appellant's September 17, 2025 and September 19, 2025 motions as petitions to rehear this court's July 17, 2025 and August 14, 2025 orders pursuant to Rule 241(d)(7) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of

¹ In Respondents' September 19, 2025 return, Respondents requested this court lift its temporary stay from its July 17, 2025 order and direct the circuit court to dissolve its stay due to Appellant's failure to comply with the undertaking. We take this opportunity to explain that this court's temporary stay dissolved upon the circuit court's issuance of an order regarding Appellant's motion to stay. Respondents' request to lift the stay imposed by the circuit court is more appropriately addressed by the circuit court.

law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied.
