Subject: Update on Matter Following October 13, 2025 Court Order

To the Honorable Clerk and Court Officials,

This correspondence serves as a formal case update pursuant to your prior instructions to provide notification within ten (10) days of any changes or developments in the matter.

Following the issuance of the October 13, 2025 Order from the South Carolina Court of Appeals, a copy of said order was immediately presented to the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Civil Division the same day, where personnel acknowledged receipt and verbally confirmed that their supervisor had been notified. The Sheriff's Office suspended execution of the writ scheduled for the following morning in recognition of the appellate order.

On October 14, 2025, stamped and time-documented copies of the appellate court order were hand-delivered to both the Spartanburg County Court of Common Pleas and the Magistrate Court, Region 2, with staff at both offices confirming receipt.

Unfortunately, despite these steps to ensure compliance with the appellate directive, a self-help eviction was carried out on October 16, 2025 by the lessor of the leasehold property, in direct contradiction to the Court's stay. No documentation was provided on site at the time of the eviction.

Further, during the eviction event, original copies of key court filings and documentation—including the Court of Appeals order and timestamped confirmations from the aforementioned offices—went missing and have not been recovered.

On October 20, 2025, the undersigned filed a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) and accompanying Rule to Show Cause in the Court of Common Pleas as an emergency response to the unlawful dispossession and destruction of legal records and materials tied to this ongoing matter.

As of October 22, 2025 **no** Court Date has been set by the circuit court of whom the case was remanded.

As of October 22, 2025 **no** rulings have been made by the Circuit Court in my Motion For **TRO** and Rule to Show Cause.

This letter is submitted in good faith as the required update, and the undersigned requests patience and understanding from the Court while efforts are made to re-secure copies of the original documentation.
