**STATUS STATEMENT AND NOTICE REGARDING ABSENCE OF
FILED ORDER**

Appellants respectfully notify the Court of Appeals that, as of October 30, 2025, the Dorchester County Public Index for case number 2024-CP-18-0459 shows no entry or filing of any signed order or decision corresponding to the October 30, 2025 email communication issued by Judge Maite Murphy's law clerk, Cheyanne Kilcoyne. That email stated that several motions were being denied and that defense counsel for D.R. Horton would draft proposed orders. However, no such orders have been entered on the official record. Accordingly, the circuit-court docket reflects no activity implementing or memorializing that correspondence.
