

ORDER

On October 6, 2025, Appellant filed a motion to strike the February 20, 2024 hearing transcript from Respondents' designation of matter, arguing it was not presented to the lower court. Respondents did not file a return. After careful consideration, Appellant's motion to strike the February 20, 2024 hearing transcript is denied. *See* Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR ("In appeals from the court of common pleas, masters-in-equity, special referees or the family court in domestic actions, the transcript must be ordered within ten (10) days after the date of service of the notice of appeal. . . . Unless the parties otherwise agree in writing, appellant must order a transcript of the entire proceedings below."); Rule 209(b), SCACR ("The Designation must clearly identify what the party desires to have included in the Record on Appeal, and the Designation may only propose to include portions of the transcript, pleadings, orders, exhibits, or other materials which may be properly included in the Record on Appeal [See Rule 210(c)].").
