## OBJECTION TO MOTION TO REINSTATE APPEAL

On October 30, 2025, the Court granted Respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal. Appellants now request that the appeal be reinstated. Respondent hereby objects to this request. Since the initial filing of Appellants' Record on Appeal on June 4, 2025, the Appellants have subsequently filed three Amended Records on Appeal. Each time, they have failed to comply with the applicable South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.


Respondent filed an Objection to the Appellant's initial Record on Appeal simply requesting that the Court require the Appellants to correct the Record on Appeal to comply with Rules 210 and Rule 267, SCACR. On August 6, 2025, the Court issued its Order striking the June 6, 2025 Record on Appeal and instructed the Appellants to file an amended record on appeal. The Court's Order listed the applicable rules and provided instructions to the Appellants as to how the matter in the Record on Appeal should be arranged and that each page should be numbered consecutively beginning with the index. Thereafter, the Respondent had to file three motions to dismiss the appeal based upon the Appellants' failure to file a Record on Appeal that complied with the applicable rules of appellate procedure as stated in the Court's June 6, 2025 Order and subsequent Orders.

In their motion to reinstate, Appellants claim that they have "encountered difficulties understanding certain technical requirements" within the rules. However, at every turn, the Court has specified the applicable rules and has stated how the Record on Appeal should be prepared. Additionally, the Respondent, in its motions to dismiss, has stated what errors there are in the Records and why those documents needed to be remedied. These errors had simple fixes, such as including items listed in the Respondent's Designation of Matter, adding page numbers throughout the record, including the relevant exhibits in the correct order, and filing their

documents in a timely manner. These are not the kind of technical requirements which require legal knowledge, and the Appellants have had numerous opportunities over the last five months to make these changes but have failed to do so each time.

Respondent has spent a significant amount of time on this case and encountered multiple delays and has incurred additional attorney fees and costs on what should have been a simple automobile repossession case. For these reasons, the Respondent requests that the court deny Appellants' motion to reinstate this appeal.
