
Hello, I am writing you in reference of the above-pending case in the Supreme Court.

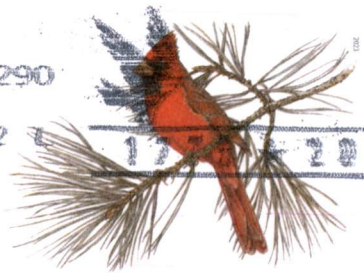
