**PETITIONER'S CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AND  
SERVE REPLY IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

AND NOW COMES Petitioner Richard D. White, by and through his undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and move for an extension of fourteen (14) days additional time to file and serve his Reply in Support of Petition for writ of *certiorari*.

1. Presently, in accordance with Rule 208(a)(2), the deadline for Petitioner's Reply in Support of Petition for writ of *certiorari* is currently November 10, 2025.
