INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT

1. Statement of the Case

This case arises from a civil dispute originally filed in Clarendon County Magistrate Civil Court, later appealed to the Clarendon County Court of Common Pleas. Appellant challenges the August 6, 2024 dismissal of her case marked "Dismissed by Court – not Rule 40J."

2. Issues on Appeal

1. Whether the lower court erred in dismissing the case without proper notice or explanation.
2. Whether the Clerk or presiding judge failed to consider Appellant's filings before dismissal.

3. Whether the dismissal violated Appellant's due process rights. **3. Statement of Facts**
Appellant filed a civil action in early 2024. Despite timely filings and compliance with court procedures, the case was dismissed without hearing or detailed reasoning. Appellant subsequently received correspondence noting deficiencies, which she has now corrected.

4. Argument

- I. The lower court erred by dismissing the case without procedural authority.
- II. Appellant was denied due process and a right to be heard.
- III. The record includes substantial evidence supporting Appellant's position.

5. Conclusion and Relief Requested

Appellant respectfully requests the Court to reverse the August 6, 2024 dismissal, remand the case for a proper hearing, and grant any other just relief.
