

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial reply brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your filing will not be considered:

- The format of the appellant's initial reply brief is incorrect. Pursuant to Rule 208(b)(3), SCACR, the reply brief shall contain a table of contents, table of cases (alphabetically arranged), statutes, and other authorities cited, with references to the pages of the reply brief where they are cited. You must serve and file an amended appellant's initial reply brief.
- An unbound copy has not been provided as required by Rule 267(d), SCACR.
- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the brief must be consecutively numbered.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption shall contain the name of the appellate court where the document is to be filed, the name of the county and judge from which the appeal is

taken including the title of the judge, the title of the case, the title of the document, and the name, address, and phone number of the party submitting the document.

- The appellant's initial reply brief and proof of service have not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
