Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I write seeking to provide the Court continued notice that I continue to be without access to my case files. I have remained without access since mid September of 2025.

Exacerbating this circumstance is the fact that the SCDC has recently implemented a policy which limits SCDC prisoners to a total of three (3) legal boxes and that the prisoner may possess only one (1) of the three (3) boxes within his cell/living unit at a time.

The prisoner is caused to leave the remaining boxes in possession of SCDC personnel, who consequently then does

Not then have the time, opportunity nor necessary staff and motivation which compels the SCDC staff to allow prisoners access to their legal boxes.


The SCDC Agency heads have created a policy which it does not have adequate staff and adequately legal educated staff to properly and equitably enforce.

The SCDC policy doesn't inform SCDC staff or mandate that SCDC staff provide access within a certain time period upon receiving an inmates request for access. Also, another policy provides a (45) forty-five day allowance before the SCDC staff is to respond to any SCDC prisoners requests.

Simply put, the new SCDC policy change is problematic and it places prose prisoners behind the 8-ball. Today's correspondence along with my prior correspondence and motions regarding the same consequently causes unnecessary pleading to then must be kept for record and maintained in ~~an~~ already full legal box.

I ask that the Court please provide me additional time and opportunity to serve and file my second amended

initial brief.


