**APPELLANT’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER
TO BE INCLUDED IN THE RECORD**

Appellant Adams Outdoor Advertising Limited Partnership (“Appellant” or “Adams”), by and through its undersigned counsel, without opposition from Respondent Beaufort County, South Carolina (“Respondent”), respectfully moves this Court, pursuant to Rules 240 and 263, SCACR, for entry of an Order extending the time within which Appellant must file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal (“Designation of Matter”) by thirty (30) days, such that the deadline would be extended to December 31, 2025. The grounds for this motion are as follows:

1. Appellant received the requested transcript of the lower court proceedings in this matter on October 31, 2025. As such, pursuant to Rules 208(a) and 209(a), SCACR, the current deadline for Appellant to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter is December 1, 2025.¹

2. Appellant seeks a 30-day extension of said deadline to allow undersigned counsel sufficient time to review the record of the lower court proceedings and prepare the Initial Brief, given existing personal and professional commitments in other matters.

3. Both of Appellant's attorneys have multiple professional commitments in the weeks leading up to the current deadline, including substantive filing deadlines and court proceedings in other cases.

4. Additionally, Appellant's attorneys will be relocating to a new office building prior to the deadline, and during this move they will have limited to no access to client files and firm systems. Finally, one of Appellant's attorneys will be out of the country for the week of Thanksgiving, and the others have plans to travel to see family during that week.

5. This is Appellant's first request for an extension of time within to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. This request is supported by good cause and is not made in an effort to unnecessarily delay these proceedings.

6. Accordingly, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court enter an Order extending the deadline to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter by thirty (30) days, such that the proposed date of the new deadline is December 31, 2025. Granting this motion would promote the interests of justice and preserve Court resources.

¹ Pursuant to Rule 263(a), SCACR, because the thirtieth day after receipt of the transcript falls on a Sunday (November 30, 2025), the current deadline runs until the end of the next business day, which is Monday, December 1, 2025.

7. This Motion is supported by the grounds set forth herein and the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Counsel for Appellant conferred with counsel for Respondent prior to filing the instant motion and can state that Respondent does not oppose the extension of time requested in this motion.
