**MOTION FOR SEVEN (7) EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AND SERVE
INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATIONS OF MATTER TO BE INCLUDED IN
THE RECORD ON APPEAL**

Pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, counsel for the Respondents hereby move for a seven (7) day extension of time in which to file and serve the Initial Brief and Designations of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. The grounds for this motion are set forth as follows:

- 1) This is the second request for an extension of this type by the party;
- 2) Per the Court’s November 12, 2025, Order denying Respondents’ Motion to Strike, the current deadline for filing of the Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter is November 27, 2025;
- 3) The insurance carrier for respondents has a requirement that all appeal briefs must be submitted to corporate headquarters for review ten (10) days prior

to filing. The due date for submitting the brief to corporate headquarters is Monday, November 17, 2025, at noon.

- 4) The undersigned has a motion for summary judgment in a pending federal case due Monday, November 17, 2025, per a filed scheduling order. The case involves numerous claims alleging violations of first amendment rights, wrongful arrest, improper use of force by law enforcement, and state law claims. The undersigned has been working on the motion and supporting memorandum when the Court's November 12th Order was issued. The undersigned anticipates needing a substantial part of the weekend to complete the motion and memorandum. Additionally, the undersigned has an in-person motion to dismiss a case against a magistrate judge to be hearing Monday morning in Chesterfield County which will take a good portion of Monday for travel and attending the roster meeting.
- 5) No additional extensions will be needed.

WHEREFORE Respondents' counsel prays for an Order extending the time in which to file and serve the Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal for an additional seven (7) days until December 4, 2025, to allow additional time to submit the completed brief to corporate headquarters for review and comment.
