This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Gabriel Curry before the Court of Appeals on November 4, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Jason R. Franks v. State with the Court of Appeals on October 27, 2025. Counsel filed

the Brief of Respondent in the case of Eric Wells v. State with the Supreme Court on October 20, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Anthony N. Briggs v. State with the Court of Appeals on October 17, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Corey T. Busch with the Court of Appeals on October 14, 2025. Counsel filed the *Johnson* Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Theia D. McArdle v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 10, 2025. Counsel appeared before Judge R. Scott Sprouse in the Oconee County Court of General Sessions for a Reconstruction Hearing in the case of The State v. William D. Gunn on October 9, 2025. Counsel attended the annual South Carolina Public Defender Conference from October 6-8, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari pursuant to Austin v. State in the case of Terry McCarrell v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 16, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Terry McCarrell v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 16, 2025.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that her caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


