2. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of State v. John M. Ghent, Jr., with the Supreme Court on November 14, 2025. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Leonard L.

Foster v. State with the Supreme Court on October 29, 2025. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Isaiah Holmes with the Court of Appeals on October 27, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Sidney Holmes v. State with the Court of Appeals on October 23, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of State v. Shanekia R. Garvin with the Supreme Court on October 2, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of State v. Jeffrey Sanders with the Supreme Court on September 26, 2025. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Philip W. Walker v. State with the Supreme Court on September 26, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Terrance Abrams with the Court of Appeals on September 24, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Michael D. Corbitt with the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals on September 19, 2025. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Demetrice R. James v. State with the Supreme Court on September 19, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Ronvarus Henderson v. State with the Supreme Court on September 18, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and in the case of Lawton Holloway v. State with the Court of Appeals on September 18, 2025.




