Motion For Extension Of Time

Introduction

COMES NOW Appellant Kitre Pugh (hereinafter “Appellant”) pursuant to Rule 207 (a) (1) SCACR, and moves this Court for an extension of time in which to file a request for transcript. The Plaintiff requests an extension of 10 days, through [November 26, 2025], to adequately prepare an agreed statement since no official transcript exists.
