APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE THE RECORD ON APPEAL  
(Rule 267(a), SCACR)

COMES NOW the Appellant, Emily Prioleau, pro se, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an extension of time to file the Record on Appeal pursuant to Rule 267(a), SCACR. In support of this motion, Appellant states:

1. Appellant is proceeding pro se and is solely responsible for preparing the Record on Appeal without legal assistance.
2. Appellant is currently experiencing significant neurological, physical, and mobility limitations that substantially impair her ability to work at a computer, handle documents, type, or complete the extensive tasks required to prepare the Record on Appeal under Rule 210, SCACR. These limitations stem from longstanding and worsening neurological and spinal conditions documented in prior filings.
3. Appellant also suffers from low vision and cannot read small print, requiring enlarged text and slow, careful review of court filings, transcripts, and exhibits. This greatly increases the time needed to review, verify, and assemble the Record on Appeal.

4. In addition to her medical limitations, Appellant is the full-time caregiver for disabled family members, which further reduces the uninterrupted time and physical capacity available to prepare the Record on Appeal.

5. Appellant previously received assistance from South Carolina Legal Services due to financial hardship and remains unable to afford private counsel, leaving her to navigate the appellate process entirely on her own while managing the limitations described above.

6. Appellant respectfully requests a sixty (60) day extension, or such longer period as this Court deems appropriate, so that she may safely and accurately complete the Record on Appeal in full compliance with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

7. This request is made in good faith, out of medical necessity, and not for the purpose of delay. Appellant will promptly file the Record on Appeal should her condition improve sooner than expected.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully prays that this Court grant a sixty (60) day extension, or such additional time as the Court deems just, for filing the Record on Appeal.
