Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Samuel Smiley v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 17, 2025.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
