




ORDER

In October 2024, the court of appeals dismissed Respondent's direct appeal of a Workers' Compensation Commission order awarding temporary total disability benefits to Respondent. Petitioners filed a petition for a writ of certiorari seeking review of the court of appeals' decision, which we granted.

Following the filing and service of Petitioners' brief, Respondent sent a letter to the Court stating she concurred with Petitioners' position that the Workers' Compensation Commission determination constituted a final decision; therefore, the order was immediately appealable.

Based on the parties' agreement, we vacate the court of appeals' order of dismissal and remand the case to the court of appeals for consideration of the merits.
