NOTICE OF APPEAL AND PETITION LODGED IN CONSCIENCE

For: South Carolina Court of Appeals (Lodged in Chambers, Not in Commerce)

By: Samuel-Tucker: Collins Jr., Trustee – STCJ Network Revocable Living Trust

Filed in Exclusive Equity – Not at Law or in Commerce

Notice of Appeal in Exclusive Equity

NOW COMES the Petitioner, **Samuel-Tucker: Collins Jr.**, Trustee of the **STCJ Network Revocable Living Trust**, appearing in **conscience** and **under Exclusive Equity jurisdiction**, not in law or commerce, to lodge this appeal for **review of matters which have no remedy in law**, and which have affected the **res and trust estate** through presumption and colorable process.

This appeal is not statutory or procedural but is:

- Lodged under **equitable maxims**,
- In accordance with **inherent appellate review under conscience**, and
- Reserved for matters **where Exclusive Equity prevails over law**, as stated in the Judicature Acts and supported by the South Carolina Constitution (1790).

Statement of Appeal and Grounds

The Petitioner appeals on the following grounds:

1. That acts were taken against the trust res under **color of law**, without **proof of standing in Exclusive Equity** by Respondent(s);
2. That the nature of the proceeding giving rise to this matter was **statutory and presumptive**, lacking conscience jurisdiction, and therefore **voidable at equity**;
3. That a proper **Resident Judge or Chancellor** has not been engaged to review the matter **in chambers**, as required under conscience jurisdiction;
4. That harm to the res has occurred without **restorative remedy** in law, and therefore requires the relief of **Equitable Restitution, Subrogation, and Injunction**, as supported by:
 - *Gibson's Suits in Chancery*,

- *Pomeroy's Equity Jurisprudence*,
- Judicature Acts of 1873/75.

Subsection: Verified Lodgment and Request for Transmission

In support of this appeal, the Petitioner affirms that the **Verified Bill in Exclusive Equity**, together with its full supporting packet and conscience-based exhibits, was properly **lodged with the Clerk of Court of Common Pleas – Clarendon County**, and **personally acknowledged by Clerk Shanita Brangman**, as evidenced by a signed lodgment receipt dated [insert exact date].

 - Equitable clarification and restraint upon those acting without standing,
 - Preservation of res, and
 - Conscience acknowledgment of the trust estate.
