MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Gerald Jarrod Ancrum respectfully submits that extraordinary

circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari, the Petition for Writ of Certiorari Pursuant to *Austin v. State*, and the Appendix in the case of Jamaques Salley v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 3, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Charles S. Anderson v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 3, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. William Lee Roseboro, Jr. with this Court on October 20, 2025. Counsel attended and presented at the mandatory Annual South Carolina Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina from October 6-8, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Robert DeJesus with this Court on October 2, 2025.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.




