## ORDER

---

On October 24, 2025, Respondent W.C. Jennings Company, Inc. moved to dismiss this appeal because Appellants failed to order the transcript of the March 24, 2025 hearing before the master-in-equity. Appellants filed a return, explaining they obtained the “transcript of testimony” on file with the Georgetown County Clerk of Court and prepared by counsel for Respondent Anderson Brothers Bank. After careful consideration, we deny the motion to dismiss.

Within ten days of the date of this order, Respondent W.C. Jennings Company, Inc. shall provide Appellants with the court reporter's contact information. Within ten days of receipt of the court reporter's contact information, Appellants shall order the transcript as required by Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules and make satisfactory arrangements, including agreement for payment, with the court reporter. Appellants shall contemporaneously furnish all parties, the Office of Court Administration, and the clerk of the appellate court with copies of all correspondence with the court reporter.
