Filing Brief Under (Rule 234 (B)), SCACR


The Appellant, Londell Lashun Alston, pursuant to Rule 234(B), SCACR, respectfully moves the court to extend the time for filing the brief of the appellant by thirty (30) days. In support of the motion, the appellant shows the following to the court:

1. Due to the negligence described below the appellant needs additional time to research and draft an adequate brief on appeal and properly frame the issues.
2. Attorney Wanda H. Carter, has displayed a blatant disregard of Rule 407, SCACR, Rules of Prof. Conduct, Rule(1.3) Diligence.
