## ORDER

On September 29, 2025, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss the appeal, arguing this court lacks appellate jurisdiction because Appellants failed to file a motion for reconsideration with the Administrative Law Court as required by South Carolina Administrative Law Court Rule 29(D) prior to filing the notice of appeal with this court. Appellants filed a return and motion to remand, opposing the dismissal, and Respondent filed a reply to Appellants' return and a return to Appellants' motion to remand, opposing a remand. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss and Appellants' motion to remand without prejudice to the parties addressing this court's appellate jurisdiction in their briefs.
