MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Telvin Quintavis Jackson respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. On December 1, 2025, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Mark T. Frick with the Court of Appeals. On November 12, 2025, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Juan Ramirez Sandoval before the Court of

Appeals. On November 6, 2025, counsel filed the initial brief of respondent and designation of matter in The State v. Joshua Brookins with the Court of Appeals. On October 16, 2025, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Jejauncey Harrington before the Court of Appeals. From October 6-8, 2025, counsel attended the Annual Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach. On September 30, 2025, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Lorenzo Young v. The State with the Supreme Court. On September 24, 2025, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Kierin Dennis before the Supreme Court. On September 5, 2025, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in In Re The Care and Treatment of George Pierson with the Court of Appeals.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. On November 26, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through January 5, 2026.


