MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Counsel for Jordin Quoleaha Glover respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension from December 5, 2025 until January 5, 2026, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Counsel filed the reply to return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Shelly Faulling v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 3, 2025. Counsel filed the reply brief


of appellant pursuant to White v. State in the case of Shelly Faulling v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 3, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jesse Broughton with the Court of Appeals on November 25, 2025. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Wiley L. Chapman before the Supreme Court on November 19, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Anthony Taylor with the Court of Appeals on October 30, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Travon Ragin with the Court of Appeals on October 10, 2025. Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of The State v. Matthew Moon with the Court of Appeals on October 3, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of John Kehborn v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 30, 2025. Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of The State v. Kereen Donyell Lee with the Court of Appeals on September 19, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Joseph Chappell v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 19, 2025.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that his caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. On November 25, 2025 opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through January 5, 2026.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty-day extension from December 5, 2025 until January 5, 2026. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


