To Whom It May Concern,

I am composing this letter to inform you all that there was an error with the Proof of Service for the Record on Appeal that was set to the SC Department of Education. While filing the initial Record on Appeal Proof of Service, I utilized the address provided by the attorney for Respondent on his Initial Respondent Brief, which was 1429 Senate Street, Suite 1015, Columbia, SC 29201 because the Rules of the Court of Appeals specify to send it to the attorney of record for the Respondent. It appears that the attorney of the Respondent, Henry Gunter Esq., included the wrong address on his Initial Respondent Brief, and he did not include the address that he initially provided. The correct address is 849 Learning Lane, West Columbia, SC 29172.

Due to this, the Record on Appeal the Appellant attempted to service to the Respondent's attorney was returned to the *pro se* Appellant on the evening of December 3, 2025. The moment that the Appellant received the returned Record on Appeal, he contacted the SC Court of Appeals to get the correct address and immediately mailed it during the hours of operation at the USPS Post Office on December 4, 2025.

The photos attached with this letter will confirm the Respondent used the incorrect address on their initial brief, the appellant serviced the Record on Appeal to the Respondent's attorney at the included incorrect address on November 17, 2025, the Record on Appeal was returned to Appellant on the evening of December 3, 2025 according to the tracking number, and the Amended Proof of Service is attached with this letter.

The Appellant made an attempt in good faith to service the Record on Appeal to the Respondent, and requests that the 20 days to file final briefs and the Record on Appeal be restarted due to the Respondent not receiving the record. I would appreciate the court giving both parties a chance to rectify this issue.
