Dear Honorable Clerk,

My name is Jesús Concepción, and I am incarcerated at the Spartanburg County Detention Center. Attached please find the filings for my Notice of Appeal, as per our conversation this morning.

I received the denied Order filed by the Court on October 14, 2025, on October 16, 2025. I received the denied Order for Reconsideration, dated October 30, 2025, on November 3, 2025.

On November 10, 2025, I filed a Notice of Appeal with the Greenville County Court of Common Pleas (please see time-stamped documents). I also forwarded a Notice of Appeal to

the Respondent on the same date. Shortly thereafter, on November 14, 2025, I mailed the Notice of Appeal to the South Carolina Court of Appeals.

As of today, I have not yet received my appellate case number. I am unsure whether this is due to non-payment of filing fees, a delay in mail delivery, or both. Within the Notice of Appeal I mailed, I also respectfully requested permission to proceed in forma pauperis, as I have been detained for more than four years and have no income. My brief has already been prepared.

Due to the limitations of being detained in a county facility and the restricted resources available, my filings may not meet the full formatting standards of the Court. I respectfully request grace and understanding from the Court; however, I want to emphasize that I have made every effort to comply as best as circumstances allow.

I spoke with someone in the Clerk's Office earlier who informed me there may be delays in mail delivery. Therefore, please accept this letter and fax as my Notice of Appeal to avoid further delay. If and when you receive the previously mailed notice, I respectfully request that you avoid duplicity and allow additional time for any correspondence sent to me, as the facility is reliable but may require extra processing time before materials reach me.
