**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO EXCEED PAGE LIMIT
AND FOR RELATED RELIEF**

Appellant Jason M. Boyle, appearing *pro se*, respectfully moves this Court for leave to exceed the standard page limit for the Final Brief of Appellant by two pages. The brief totals 52 pages, rather than 50.

Appellant offers the following grounds in support of this motion:

1. The Additional Pages Result Only From Required Citations and Descriptors

The substantive content of the brief has not been expanded. Appellant added:

1. **Record on Appeal references**, and
2. **short descriptive phrases** accompanying those references to improve clarity and aid the Court's review.

Other than correcting a small number of typographical errors, no new arguments, issues, or substantive material were added. The brief grew by two pages solely because the required citations increased page length in a way Appellant could not avoid.

2. Request for Leniency Regarding Pro Se Formatting

As a self-represented litigant, Appellant has endeavored to comply fully with all formatting rules.

If minor formatting irregularities remain, Appellant respectfully asks the Court to extend leniency consistent with the general principle that pro se filings are construed liberally.

The purpose of this motion is not to enlarge the substance of the brief, but simply to allow the Court to accept it with the citations necessary for accurate review.

3. International Location, Extraordinary Shipping Costs, and Request for Receipt

Confirmation

Appellant is currently outside the United States. Shipping printed and bound copies of the brief and the Record on Appeal is **extremely expensive**. Appellant is using a printing and binding service to produce the required copies, which will then be mailed to the Court and counsel.

Appellant will provide **receipts** for printing and shipping with tracking upon shipment.

Appellant respectfully requests:

Notification from the Court, the Attorney General's Office, and Attorney Jim Logan upon receipt of the printed materials.

4. Documents Are Dated as of the Date Sent to the Printer and Emailed to the Court

Because of Appellant's international location and the reliance on commercial printing services, all documents submitted in this stage of the appeal are **dated as of the day they are emailed to the Court and sent to the printer** for mailing. This ensures consistent dating, reflects the true filing date, and avoids confusion caused by the unavoidable delay between printing and delivery.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court:

1. **Grant leave to exceed the page limit** by two pages and accept the Final Brief of Appellant as filed;
2. Accept the brief notwithstanding any minor formatting variations resulting from pro se preparation;
3. Provide notification to Appellant upon receipt of the printed briefs and Record on Appeal;
and

4. Grant such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.


