

## ORDER

On November 4, 2025, Appellants filed a "Motion to Object to Unauthorized Rulings and to Enforce Appellate Jurisdiction," seeking an order (1) declaring all rulings, drafts, or orders issued by the circuit court after August 13, 2025 null and void; (2) directing the circuit court to cease any further action, ruling, or correspondence; (3) confirming the jurisdictional authority of this court; (4) reminding the circuit court and its staff of Canon 3(B)(7) of the Code of Judicial Conduct and Rule 205 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules; and (5) granting other relief that this court deems proper. On November 14, 2025, Appellants filed a "Supplement to Motion to Object to Unauthorized Ruling and to Enforce Appellate Jurisdiction and Emergency Notice of Objection and Fraud." Respondent did not file a return.

After careful consideration of the November 4, 2025 motion and November 14, 2025 supplement, we deny Appellant's requested relief in the "Motion to Object to Unauthorized Rulings and to Enforce Appellate Jurisdiction."
