Dear Ms. Fulton:

Upon reviewing your motion to reinstate, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your filing will not be considered. This is the Court's third request for these corrections:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, the proof of service does not state that a copy of the motion to reinstate has been served on the respondent.
- The motion and proof of service have not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- The required filing fee has not been received as of the date of this letter. The correct filing fee is \$50.00.
