MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Ezra Rysunn Williams respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from December 15, 2025 until January 14, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Ezra Rysunn Williams respectfully submits that extraordinary


circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Jerald Jermaine Howard v. The State with this Court on December 12, 2025. Counsel with co-counsel W. Chandler Norville filed the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Ri'Shon Keltarian Gilliam with the Court of Appeals on November 26, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Blaton W. Smith v. The State with this Court on November 24, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Reply Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Clifton Kimble with the Court of Appeals on November 20, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Mason Christopher Yarborough before the Court of Appeals on November 4, 2025.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. On November 25, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through January 5, 2026.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty (30) day extension from December 15, 2025 until January 14, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.
