**RESPONDENT SOUTH CAROLINA FEDERAL CREDIT UNION'S  
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

---

Pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court Rules 240 and 263(b), Respondent South Carolina Federal Credit Union moves for an extension of twenty-five (25) days from the existing deadline of December 15, 2025, to file its Final Brief. Respondent's Final Brief will be due on or before January 9, 2025, if the extension is granted.

Respondent respectfully submits that a twenty-five (25) day extension to file its Final Brief is appropriate due to (1) Appellant's failure to correctly paginate the Record on Appeal and include

in the Record on Appeal all items designated by Respondent,<sup>1</sup> (2) counsel's existing work demands, and (3) the upcoming holiday and end of year schedule.

In addition to the requested extension, Respondent further requests that the Court order Appellant to file an amended Record on Appeal which (a) complies with the pagination requirements of Rule 210(c), SCACR, and (b) includes all items designated for inclusion by Respondent, including those identified in footnote 1 to this Motion.

For the reasons set forth herein, Respondent requests an extension until January 9, 2025, to file and serve its Final Brief and that the Court order Appellant to correct the Record on Appeal as set forth herein.

<sup>1</sup> The most recent Record on Appeal submitted by Appellant, which was received by the South Carolina Court of Appeals on December 2, 2025, does not contain consecutive page numbering as required under Rule 210(c), SCACR, despite the Clerk's office having notified Appellant on November 18, 2025, of Appellant's previous failure to comply with Rule 210. As such, Respondent is unable to prepare Respondent's Final Brief in compliance with Rule 211(b)(1), SCACR.

Additionally, the Record on Appeal does not include several of Respondent's designations reflected in Respondent's Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal filed on September 10, 2025. The following designations are missing from the Record on Appeal and must be included in order for Respondent to prepare and submit its Final Brief:

- Plaintiff's Complaint filed May 9, 2024;
- Appellant's Answer filed June 24, 2024;
- Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment filed July 18, 2024;
- Affidavit of Sonya Medlock in Support of Motion for Summary Judgment and Exhibits 1-4 thereto filed July 18, 2024; and
- Notice of Hearing filed September 6, 2024.


