Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Davanta Johnson v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 5, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Ronzell Bilah Olds with the Court of Appeals on October 23, 2025. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter, and record on appeal in the case of The State v. Terrele Bailey with the Court of Appeals on October 21, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Antrell Felder v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 17, 2025.

3. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


